

KNOW YOUR PLASTIC AND RECYCLE

RECYCLE:



High density polyethylene (HDPE)
pesticide containers can be any colour and are generally firm, but soft to the touch (different volumes).



Low density polyethylene (LDPE)
bags are clear and usually used as lining in paper or PP bags for granular or powdery pesticides.



Polypropylene (PP)
pesticide bags and tubs can be any colour and there's a large variety of sizes. The bags crumble easily if left in the sun.

KEEP SEPARATE AND SEND FOR INCINERATION:



Polyethylene terephthalate (PET or PETE)
pesticide bottles are thin and firm (mostly 1 litre, 2 litre, 5 litre and Ready-To-Use). Look out for identification triangles embossed underneath the containers or printed on bags.
